1. Commitment to Accessibility

Walcott Parish Council is committed to making its website accessible to everyone, including people with disabilities. We aim to ensure that the content on this website is as accessible and usable as possible for all visitors.

2. Compliance Status

We are striving to meet the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 AA standards and to comply with the *Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) (No. 2) Accessibility Regulations 2018*.

While the site's underlying system supports accessible features (e.g., semantic HTML and keyboard navigation), some content — especially older PDF documents, images without descriptive text, or files uploaded by third parties — may not fully meet all accessibility criteria at this time.

Where possible, the site should:

- be navigable using keyboard controls (e.g., Tab key)
- support zooming up to at least 200 % using browser controls
- work with screen readers and assistive technologies

Despite our efforts, some areas may not be fully accessible; for example:

- some downloadable documents (such as older PDFs) may not be accessible to screen readers
- images and embedded content may lack accessible text alternatives
- navigation or layout may not be ideal for all assistive technology users
