

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C636 North Walsham Road from its junction with Paston Road for 515m eastwards in the PARISH OF PASTON because of fibre overhead cabling works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 09:30 and 15:00 on 10<sup>th</sup> February 2022 for the duration of the works expected to be about 5 ½ hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: North Walsham Road, Bacton Road, Crow Road, Mundesley Road, Lyngate Road, North Walsham Bypass, Yarmouth Road, Dilham Bridleway 13, Dilham Footpath 14, Chapel Terrace, Norwich Road, Wayford Road, Stepping Stone Lane, Stalham Road, Coast Road (Dilham, Brumstead, Stalham, Worstead, Smallburgh, East Ruston, Witton, Paston, Walcott, Bacton, North Walsham).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

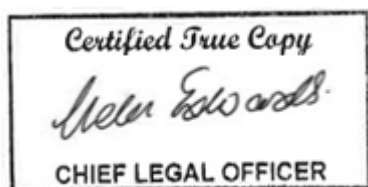
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
