

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the U19021 Mill Road from its junction with North Walsham Road for 30m southwards in the PARISHES OF EDINGTHORPE & BACTON because of BT plant repair works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) on 3rd May 2022 for the duration of the works.

Alternative route is via: U19021 Mill Road, C636 Bacton Road, C417 Old Hall Road, North Walsham Road, C503 Happisburgh Road, U19661 Manor Road, U19021 Anchor Road, The Street (Witton, Bacton, North Walsham)

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

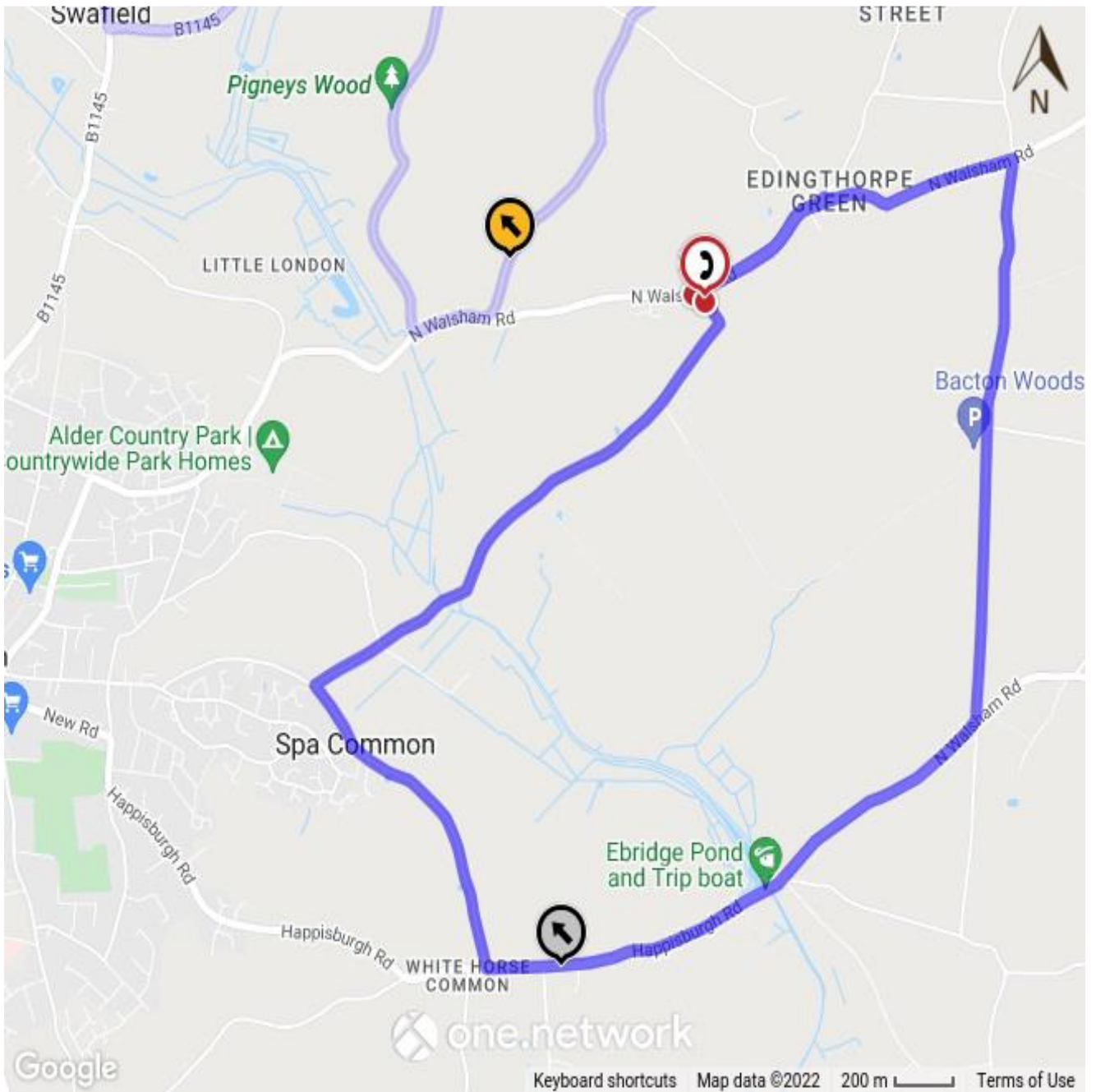
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
