

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C634 Bacton Road from 100m south eastwards of its junction with Vicarage Road for 50m in the PARISH OF PASTON because of Anglian Water new connection works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 18<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> May 2022 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: C634 Bacton Road, B1159 Paston Road, B1159 Coast Road, B1159 Church Road, B1159 Walcott Road, B1159 Stalham Road, B1159 Stepping Stone Lane, A149 Wayford Road, A149 Norwich Road, A149 Yarmouth Road, A149 North Walsham By-pass, B1145 The Street, B1145 Knapton Road, B1145 North Walsham Road, B1145 Mundesley Road, C634 Water Lane (Dilham, Brumstead, Stalham, Worstead, Smallburgh, Knapton, East Ruston, Paston, Walcott, Bacton, Swafeld, Mundesley, North Walsham).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
