

With energy prices rising, Norfolk councils want to make homes more energy-efficient by

making improvements to them at no cost to the tenant.

First we insulate the property as nearly 60% of heat is lost through the walls and roof, so this makes a big difference to the energy efficiency. After we have done this there may be other ways in which we can help such as installing air source heat pumps, these will depend on the suitability of your property.

Who is entitled to this help?
