Reduce your heating bills and your carbon footprint

With energy prices rising Norfolk councils want to make homes more energy-efficient by making improvements to them at no cost to the homeowner.

First we insulate the property fully. Nearly 60% of your heat is lost through the walls and roof, so this makes a big difference to the energy efficiency. Once we have done this there may be other ways in which we can help you, such as installing air source heat pumps - these are all dependent on individual circumstances.

Who is entitled to this help?

We want to hear from people who are living in properties with low energy ratings – typically an EPC rating of E, F or G. These are the homes that lose the most heat and so are the ones we can help most.

You also need to have a gross household income of under £30,000 (including any benefits) to be eligible for home improvements.

Where does this money come from?

Norfolk Warm Homes has received funding through the Government's Sustainable Warmth Scheme, with the goal of upgrading some of the most inefficient homes in the county.

Three steps to getting a warm home:
