

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO6681) affecting the Anchor Road/Mill Road from 300m west of its junction with Marshgate for 80m westwards in the TOWN OF NORTH WALSHAM and PARISH OF BACTON to facilitate bridge repair works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 26th to 7th July 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 12 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Mill Road, North Walsham Road, Bacton Road, Old Hall Road, North Walsham Road, Happisburgh Road, Manor Road, Anchor Road (Witton, Bacton, North Walsham).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

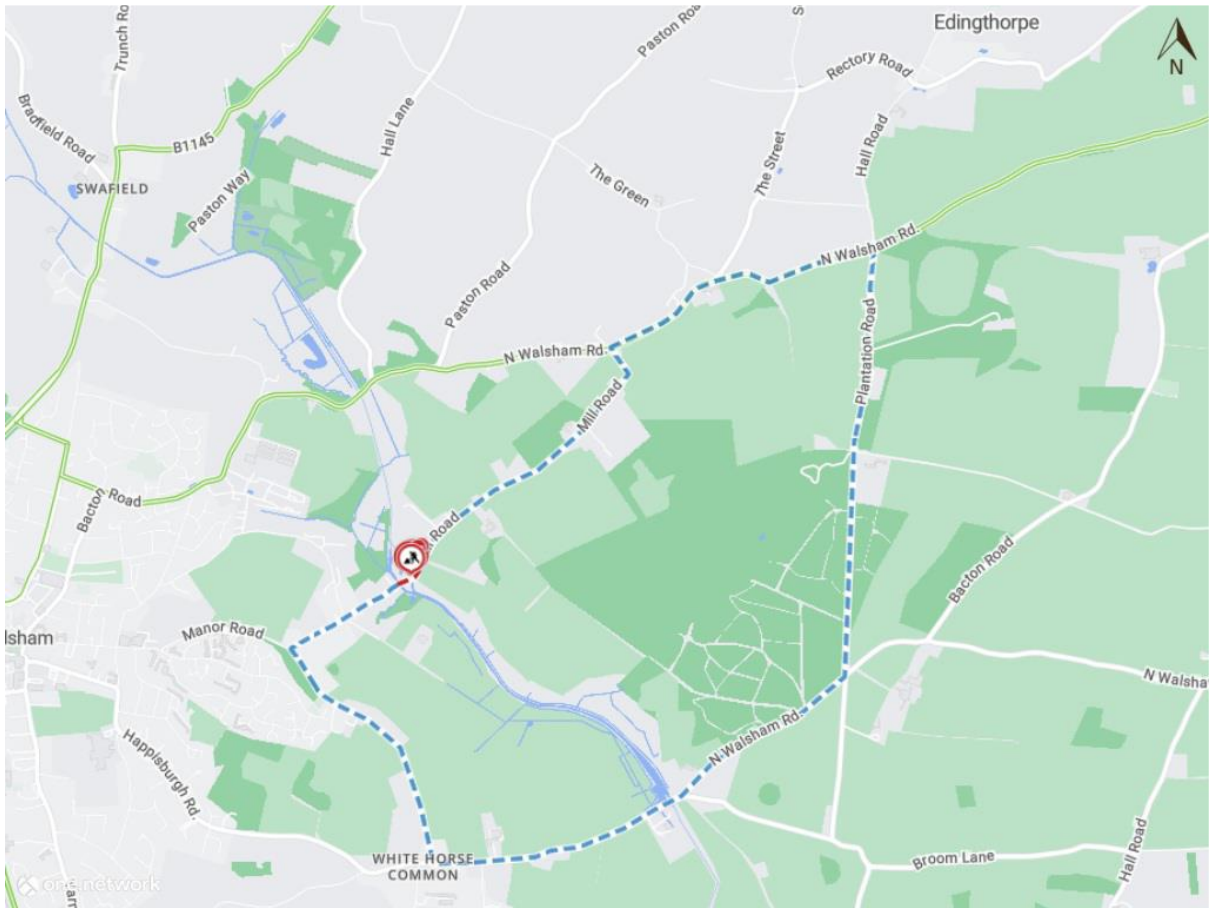
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
