NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7144) affecting the Happisburgh Road from its junction with Furze Hill Road for 280m eastwards in the TOWN OF NORTH WALSHAM to facilitate tree removal works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 1 day within the period.

Alternative route is via: Happisburgh Road, North Walsham Road, Happisburgh Road, North Walsham Road, B1159 Stalham Road/Stepping Stone Lane, A149 Wayford Road/Yarmouth Road/North Walsham By-pass, Norwich Road, Grammar School Road, Yarmouth Road, New Road, Happisburgh Road (Dilham, Worstead, Witton, Walcott, Smallburgh, Brumstead, Stalham, Honing, East Ruston, North Walsham).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
