

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C503 Happisburgh Road from its junction with U19661 Manor Road to its junction with U19020 Meeting Hill Road in the TOWN OF NORTH WALSHAM because of BT underground service works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) on 19th October 2022 for the duration of the works expected to be about 1 day within the period.

Alternative route is via: Happisburgh Road, North Walsham Road, Old Hall Road, Bacton Road, North Walsham Road, Bacton Road, Bluebell Road, Marshgate, Pound Road, Happisburgh Road (Witton, Paston, Bacton, North Walsham).

(If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
