WHAT HAVE WE BEEN UP TO?

Four teenagers were arrested in connection with a series of robberies that took place on 11 February 2023 in North Walsham. They have been released on bail while enquiries continue.

Our North Walsham Beat Managers held engagement events at St Benets' Hall, Mundesley Library, and various supermarkets, where the public were able to raise any concerns they had.

We conducted speed checks on Happisburgh Road, White Horse Common, and in Worstead where seven people in total were stopped and spoken to.

We've visited local schools including Antingham & Southrepps Primary School, and North Walsham High School to speak to children about staying safe.

Our response officers have been conducting high visibility patrols and will continue to, as part of our 'Park, Walk, Talk' initiative.
