

Good afternoon,

As summer approaches, onshore construction work continues to progress on RWE's Vanguard East, Vanguard West and Boreas offshore wind farms. This notably includes the installation of underground ducting along the remainder of the cable route, from the I Wensum towards landfall at Happisburgh, as well as construction at the onshore substation location in Necton.

To keep members of your communities up to date, we are holding a range of public information drop-in sessions. These are an opportunity to call by and meet members of the projects, with representatives from communications, land and construction teams, across RWE and Murphy.
