

Notice of NTRO11496, Bacton

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO11496) affecting C636 Bacton Road from its junction with Mill Road to its junction with The Street (the "Road") in the Parish of Bacton to facilitate pole test works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 09:30 and 15:30 on the 2nd October 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 13th November 2026 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: C636 Bacton Road/ Pollard Street/ North Walsham Road, B1159 Walcott Road/ Coast Road/ Stalham Road/ Stepping Stone Lane, A149 Wayford Road/ Norwich Road/ Yarmouth Road, B1145 North Walsham By-pass, C636 Lyngate Road/ Mundesley Road/ Crow Road (East Ruston, Witton, Stalham, Dilham, Paston, Smallburgh, Bacton, Brumstead, Worstead, Walcott, North Walsham).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: BT.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 13th November 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

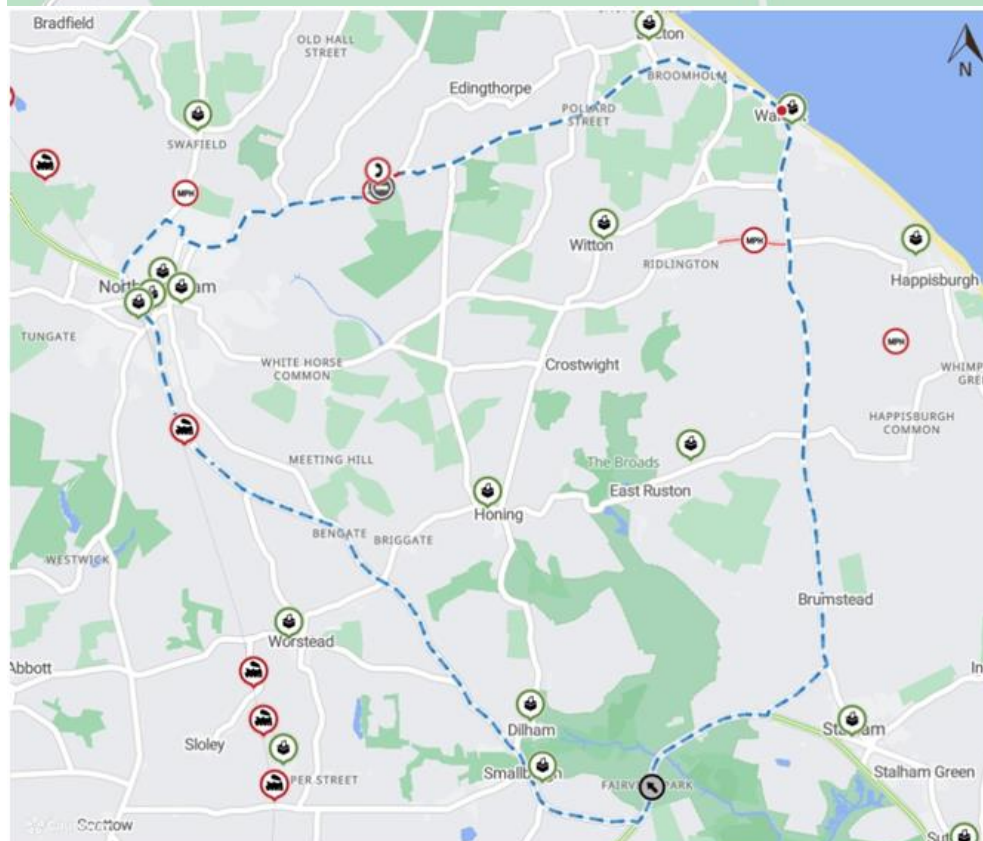
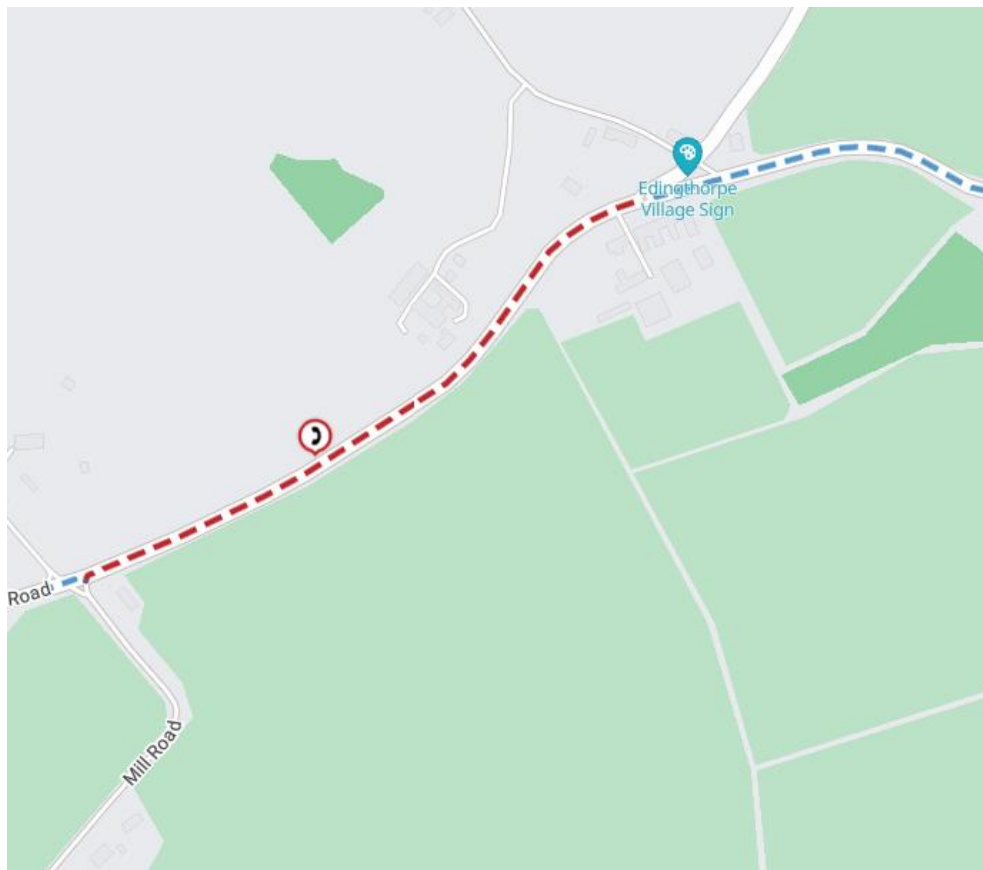
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
