North Walsham (East)

Campaign to improve pavement surfaces for those with Mobility aids:

- The pavement opposite Sainsburys Petrol Station is to be resurfaced as part of the Bacton Road resurfacing.
- Following the re-requesting of resurfacing the pavement on Bacton Road beyond the cemetery, some areas have been scheduled for improvement.
- Pavement near the Post Office has been scheduled for improvement.
- The slope joining Royston Green to Melbourne Road will now be resurfaced.

Bacton Road resurfacing will require a full road closure, which will mean that access to homes and local businesses will be disrupted. The work to Lidl junction will be undertaken at the same time:

- The date for this is not set yet.

Sainsburys Update:

- Overgrowing trees from forecourt into the neighbouring garden:
 - The trees have been cut back to the side; the rear is still to be scheduled.
- Vehicles missing Vicarage Street turning are turning into Greenway Close:
 - The store is going to install additional signage at Vicarage Street junction with Mundesely Road. Highways have given permission.
- The planted area alongside the petrol station has overgrown and the fence panels have fallen:
 - Awaiting action, the initial quotation from the store's suppliers has come back over budget. The store is investigating other avenues.

Trees:

- The fenced off tree on Hall Lane has had paving slabs removed and replaced with shingle.
- A tree on Pound Road will be felled due to drilling/nails in the trunk and suspected poisoning.
