

Notice of NTRO11560, Walcott

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO11560) affecting **A) B1159 Coast Road** from 10 metres north of its junction with 1P242 Poplar Drive for 100 metres north-westwards ("Road A") and **B) B1159 Coast Road** from 172 metres northwest of its junction with 1P242 Poplar Drive for 58 metres north-westwards ("Road B") in the Parish of Walcott to facilitate carriageway drainage works. Road A will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) and traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over Road B will be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 28th September to 20th November 2026, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 20th May 2027 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: B1159 Coast Road/ Stalham Road/ Stepping Stone Lane, A149 Wayford Road/ Norwich Road/ Yarmouth Road/ North Walsham Bypass, B1145 North Walsham Bypass/ The Street/ Knapton Road/ North Walsham Road/ Mundesley Road, Water Lane, Paston Road, Stow Hill, Mundesley Road, B1159 Bacton Road/ Paston Road/ Coast Road/ Walcott Road/ Coast Road (East Ruston, Stalham, Dilham, Swafeld, Paston, Smallburgh, Bacton, Brumstead, Mundesley, Worstead, North Walsham, Knapton, Walcott).

NB: Road A is anticipated to be closed from 28th October to 20th November 2026. Road B is anticipated to be restricted from 28th September to 27th October 2026.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in Road A where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 20th May 2027 without further notice.

If necessary, the closure/restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure/restriction imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

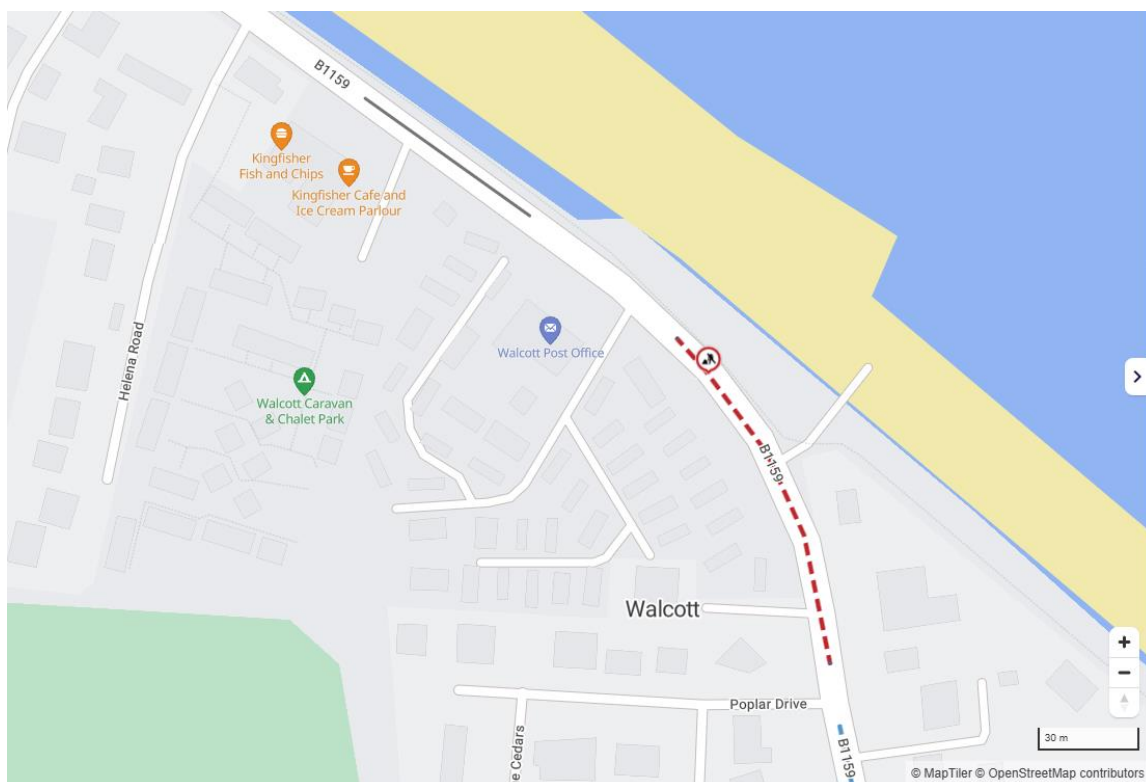
